

# Lyman Whitaker, Sculptor

A native of Utah, Lyman has been a practicing sculptor for over fifty years. He is internationally known as a master in the kinetic sculpture discipline. Wind Sculptures – his main focus since the mid-1980's – are innovative, artistic, and responsive to their natural surroundings. Lyman's work is represented at select fine art galleries throughout the United States and abroad. His work is at home in most of the world's climates both in small-scaled private installations as well as large-scale public venues.
